**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES) (PARTS OF C140 STRATFORD ROAD AND C155 GREAT MONKS STREET (V5), MILTON KEYNES) (30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2015) VARIATION ORDER 2018**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Orders under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the above Orders will be to replace the existing national speed limit along part of Stratford Road, Wolverton (between V5 Great Monks Street and Queen Eleanor Street) with a 40mph speed restriction.

The proposal will provide continuity of the speed limit along the entire length of this section of Stratford Road.

On 18<sup>th</sup> October 2018 Milton Keynes Council served the Notice of Proposal and carried out 21 days statutory consultation on the above proposed Order.

During the consultation period the Council received fourteen representations to the proposed Order. Thirteen representations were in favour and one objected to the proposed Order.

The Council has carefully considered the one objection to the proposed Order and has decided to make the Order as originally proposed.

The made Traffic Regulation Order will come into effect on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2018.

A copy of the made Order together with a map showing the areas referred to, may be inspected during opening hours at Milton Keynes Council, Synergy Park, 1 Chesney Wold, Bleak Hall, Milton Keynes, MK6 1LY.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any provision contained in the Orders on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under the Act has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
